All master's students must complete a tentative degree plan, which is approved by the adviser, no later than the second quarter of residence at PSU. This document is a "living document" and can be changed. NOTE: all changes must be initialed and dated by both the student and the adviser. All master's students must complete two courses from one of the (S) Graduate Course Sequences listed in the ECE Graduate Handbook. All Pre-admission and Transfer credits MUST be approved by both the ECE Department and the Office of Graduate Studies (use OGS' GO-21form). Use the columns on the right to indicate approved (P) Pre-admission (taken at PSU before formal admission) and (T) Transfer credits (taken at another institution). Master's students may apply no more than three credits of ECE 507 Graduate Seminar toward degree elective requirements. Courses with a grade of C+ or lower can not be used toward the 36 credit ECE lecture requirement.
